

CAMDEN PROPERTY TRUST ANNOUNCES TAX CHARACTERISTICS OF 2015 DISTRIBUTIONS

Houston, TEXAS (January 19, 2016) - Camden Property Trust (NYSE:CPT) announced today the income tax characteristics of its 2015 distributions paid to shareholders as they will be reported on Form 1099-DIV. For corporate shareholders the Section 291(a) preference item is 1.5951% of the total distribution.
